

## **IMPORTANT IMMIGRATION INFORMATION FOR DISTRICT CONFERENCE**

**We look forwards to seeing you at our Rotary District 7020 Conference in St. Thomas April 12-16, 2011. St. Thomas, is in the US Virgin Islands which are under the jurisdiction of the United States of America. As such, people entering the US Virgin Islands are required to be in possession of a Visa for the United States.**

**Rotary District 7020 cannot assist you with the application for a visa; your application will need to be completed on line and submitted according to the instructions which you will find at <http://haiti.usembassy.gov/visas.html> or [http://french.haiti.usembassy.gov/visa\\_de\\_sejour\\_temporaire.html](http://french.haiti.usembassy.gov/visa_de_sejour_temporaire.html)**

**We strongly urge you to do the following:**

- 1. Complete your application IMMEDIATELY, since the visa processing at the US Embassy will take some time.**
- 2. Register for the conference: your registration and payment will indicate your intention to attend the conference at <http://www.district7020conference.com/registration.htm>**
